

BIOCOMPLET MINI

ORGANIC FEEDING SYSTEM FOR GROWING GOATS AND SHEEP

A **complete feed** for all ruminant species in the **juvenile stage** from post-weaning onwards;

- can be used on cattle up to 150 days of age;
- on sheep and goats up to the time before the first calving.

It can be a valuable **feed base to complement grazing** or other **on-farm feeds**. Most of the ingredients are **forages, alfalfa** in various forms and **grass hay**.

Biocomplet Mini is formulated to ensure an optimal nutritional contribution due to the high quality of the forages used in its composition. They also provide the structured fibre base necessary to stimulate **rumen motility** and promote **rumen morphological and functional enhancement**.

PACKAGING

- in bulk;
- 400/500 kg bales tied with iron wire;
- bales of approximately 25 kg wrapped in recyclable plastic, pre-cut into 4 portions and packaged in blocks of 48 bales on pallets.

TIPS FOR CORRECT USE

The **Biocomplet Mini** can form a core around which **pasture, forages and farm concentrates** can be combined to make a ration tailored to the needs of the animals, depending on species and stage.

Remove the packaging and each bale will divide into four compact portions: on very young animals, particularly kids and lambs, it is advisable to break up the portions initially. Then make the quarters available without altering their structure: this will limit the natural tendency of the animals to select the components, making the intake of the ration more regular.

If pasture is available, make the product available in the same way during housing: the animals themselves will self-regulate the ingestion.

In ad libitum feeding, the voluntary daily intake can be as high as 1.5 kg in small ruminants;

- **Small ruminants** to 1.0-1.2 kg;
- **Cattle close to 150 days** of age to 4-6 kg.

If it is necessary to comply with the prescribed feeding regime, Biocomplet Mini can be rationed in quantities dependent on the composition of the rest of the ration. In this case, it is recommended to work under the guidance of a qualified technician.
